

**1/2026 Dean's Instruction  
on the Conduct Guidelines for Demonstrators  
at the Faculty of Science and Informatics of the University of Szeged**

**I. Interpretative provisions**

1. The task of the demonstrator is to support the work of the instructors in educational, organizational and administrative activities, as well as to assist the students in the learning process.
2. The demonstrator plays a mediating role between the instructors and students, and serves as a professional and ethical example.
3. The demonstrator is in a unique position, as they act both as a student and as an educator.

**II. Conduct Requirements for Demonstration Activities**

1. Students performing demonstration duties are required to adhere to the following conduct requirements. They should
  - a) communicate with all students in a respectful, helpful and professional manner,
  - b) treat students impartially and fairly, regardless of personal relationships,
  - c) avoid favoritism or bias, especially in assessment or information-sharing transfer situations,
  - d) maintain professional boundaries and act as an educational facilitator in their role,
  - e) treat all information related to student performance or assessment as confidential,
  - f) demonstrate exemplary behavior within the university community, with particular attention to cooperation, respect, and academic integrity,
  - g) in the event of a conflict or problematic situation, further the matter to the appropriate instructor or department head,
  - h) use Coospace and Neptun as the official means of communication with students (other platforms may be used with the permission of the institute).
2. Failure to comply with the above conduct requirements will result in termination of the assignment to be a demonstrator.

These instructions shall enter into force on 23 March 2026. Students already performing demonstrator duties at the time of entry into force are required to comply with these provisions.
